Packing infrequently used items

Deciding what to keep, donate, or discard

Arranging schools and childcare for your children, including new uniforms

Creating a moving budget and estimating costs

Researching temporary storage options near your new home

Recording important moving details (Information and Conversations) in a journal

Coordinating time off work, if needed

Ordering packing supplies, including cardboard boxes

ONE MONTH PRIOR TO MOVING DAY

Prepare your pets for the move by visiting the vet for necessary certificates. Also, arrange for their safe transportation to your new location

Book your travel arrangements to your new location, if necessary

Arrange to transfer your child's school records

Notify utility companies of your move

Reconfirm your move date with your chosen moving company

Provide your landlord with at least 28 days' written notice of your intention to vacate

Confirm your moving schedule with relevant parties, such as your landlord or real estate agent

THREE WEEKS PRIOR TO MOVING DAY

Secure your valuables in a safe location

Dispose of unwanted items before the move

Create a list of parties to notify about your move

Determine the deadline for signing and completing necessary documents

TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO MOVING DAY

Schedule a pre-move-out inspection with your landlord

Notify friends and family of your new address using change of address cards

Arrange for mail redirection with your postal service

ONE WEEK PRIOR TO MOVING DAY

Gather essentials for moving day, including contact numbers, documents, and cleaning supplies

Settle any outstanding bills before the move

Arrange childcare or pet care for moving day

Separate items for movers and personal transport, keeping valuables like jewelry with you

Use up food and defrost fridge/freezer for the move

Book a professional cleaner for after the move to save time and hassle

Confirm key collection or pickup for your new place

Pack essentials like toiletries, medications, and a change of clothes for each person

Prepare "essentials boxes" for kids with favorite toys, snacks, drinks, and entertainment like comic books

FINALIZE THE MOVE

Clear space for movers to park and work

Secure the old home by locking doors and windows

Record final readings of electric and gas meter and store safely

Do a final, thorough check of everything

Hand over all necessary keys, including window and bolt keys, to the agent or new owners

Prioritize setting up beds, and tackle the rest later. Take a moment to celebrate your accomplishment

ONCE SETTLED

Document lost/damaged items and notify movers or insurance company

Gradually introduce kids and pets to their new space

Update locks for added security
